Scholarship Criteria

- 2019 graduation from high school and enrollment in a college or university in pursuit of a degree program or in a vocational school.
- Years and depth of participation in YHCHC sponsored rodeos and activities
 - This includes participation as a contestant in the annual series sponsored by YHCHC and special events such as jackpot rodeos, practice sessions, schools and other activities which may occur from time to time.
 - Performance results are not considered, but rather the diligence demonstrated through continued effort and participation.
- Character values consistent with our western heritage such as respect, determination, self-reliance, effort, dependability, sportsmanship etc.
- Community involvement and demonstration of leadership activities.
- Demonstration of continued interest and participation in rodeo beyond the high school level with emphasis on participation in college rodeo through the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association (NIRA).
- Participation in other rodeo organizations.

A three-member scholarship committee will be selected by the YHCHC Board of Directors each year. This committee shall prepare a recommendation to the YHCHC Board each year detailing the amount, number and recipients of scholarships
